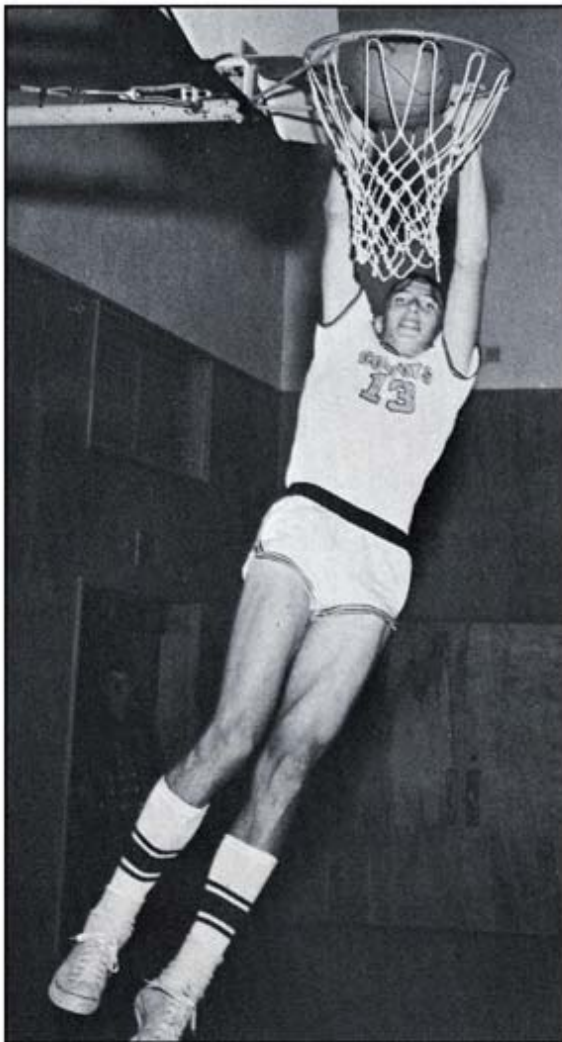


LIVERMORE SPORTS HALL OF FAME

ERWIN MUELLER

**Two-Time All League at Livermore High
All-Conference & All-American at USF
Selected as 10th Pick in The NBA Draft
Earned NBA All-Rookie Team Honors**



At 6'8" in height, Erwin played center for the Livermore High Cowboys and was twice elected to the All-League First Team before graduating in 1962.

He went on to play center/forward for the University of San Francisco Dons where he was earned All-Pacific Coast, All-Conference, and All-American Honors.

Selected as the 10th pick in the 1966 NBA Draft by the Chicago, he went on to score 12.7 points per game in his first season with the Bulls and was selected to the NBA's All Rookie Team.

Erwin played a total of seven seasons in the NBA and scored a career total of 3,248 points. In addition to Chicago, he played for the Los Angeles Lakers, the Seattle Supersonics, and the Detroit Pistons.

He then moved to the rival American Basketball Association, playing two more years as a member of the newly formed Virginia Squires and Memphis Tams.
